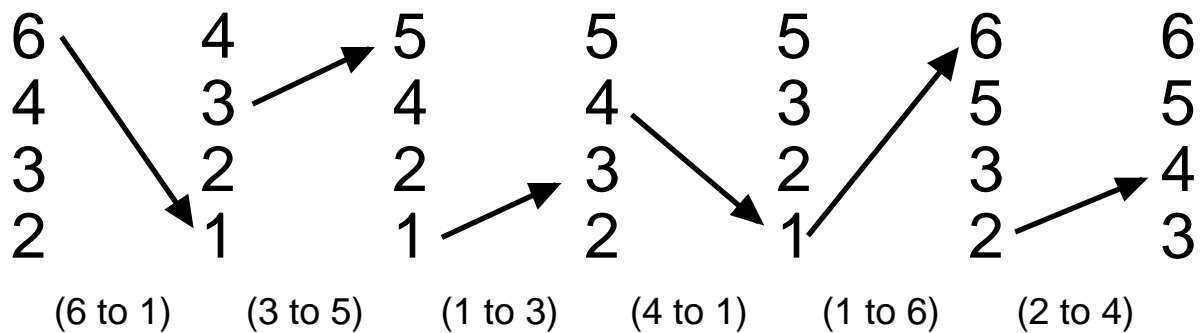


# Chord Inversion

The following method will generate 28 inversions for any 4 note chord on the guitar.

Start with any chord on the strings 6-4-3-2. **Invert** the chord by moving each note in the chord up, on the same string, to the next note in the chord. Do this 3 times (the 4th time will give you the same voicing you started with, one octave higher).

To generate voicings on other string groups, **transfer** a note from one string to another. In other words, move the note from one string to another (up or down an octave). Be sure to delete the "old" note. This will produce the same four notes, in a different order, with no doublings. Follow this order: (numbers indicate strings)



Do all 4 inversions on each string group. 7 string groups times 4 inversions will give you 28 inversions.

Do the following chord types:

Dom7	Maj7	m7	m7b5	dim7
Maj 6	m6	Dom7sus	Dom7b5	Dom7#5
m(maj7)	Maj7b5	Maj7#5	dim(maj7)	

Transpose to all keys.
